Directors' Report

Choir Patron numbers are up this year.

Homecoming is Sept. 23rd. The check for the PTSA for \$25 for Homecoming has been sent.

The Choir's theme for the Homecoming Parade is Jungle Book. John Hairel will be driving the truck again this year—still looking for a trailer.

The Musical was just announced—Footloose. Need Choir Boosters help to feed the Director's on the nights of Sept. 13, 14, and 15 for late night auditions.

There will be no 9-10 Region Choir this year. All students audition for the main region choir.

Fun things planned for the NYC trip-clinic with actor from Aladdin; One World Trade Center visit, tour in Central Park, NBC new studio tour, Times Square, Circle Tour around Statue of Liberty among the possibilities; requesting to sing at St. Patrick's Cathedral; cost will be ~\$1300. The Dates will be Saturday May 13 – Tuesday May 16.

- Keeping choir derby car races on one day (Sat., April 29th), as it worked well to do that last year.
- Big Event is on April 1st, 2017.
- NYC trip is May 13-16. Return on a Tuesday with Hawk Awards that night.
- Choir banquet date changed to Tuesday, May 23rd. Hebron choir has been asked to perform with Southwestern Mississippi State University on Sunday afternoon May 21st.
- Dessert concert dates set for May 25-26.
